# Important information for all centres.

There has been a surge of centre delegates contacting the central team, as a learner this must be hugely irritating and a waste of time and effort for everyone concerned.

We want you all to take the following 3 simple steps to ensure that your centre is set up to fully support all your learners.



### 1. Prevent issues

- Ensure <a href="mailto:normal">noreply@dls.nhs.uk</a> is on your organisation's approved list of senders. You will need help from your local IT service Desk to get this in place across the organisation.
- Learners should be asked to check their junk folders for mail from <a href="mailto:odds.nhs.uk">odds.nhs.uk</a>

### 2. Publicise local support

Make YOUR learners aware of YOUR local contact details not ours

Check your centre details are available and accurate.

### 3. Provide support

Delegates are the responsibility of the centre not the central team and one of the most common issue being reported is password recovery.

A new Tracking System feature has been introduced to help your centre administrators set a temporary password for a delegate and notify them via email from the Tracking System.
