Important information for all centres.

There has been a surge of centre delegates contacting the central team, as a learner this must be hugely irritating and a waste of time and effort for everyone concerned.

We want you all to take the following 3 simple steps to ensure that your centre is set up to fully support all your learners.



1. Prevent issues

- Ensure <u>noreply@dls.nhs.uk</u> is on your organisation's approved list of senders. You will need help from your local IT service Desk to get this in place across the organisation.
- Learners should be asked to check their junk folders for mail from @dls.nhs.uk

2. Publicise local support

Make YOUR learners aware of YOUR local contact details not ours

3. Provide support

Delegates are the responsibility of the centre not the central team and one of the most common issue being reported is password recovery.

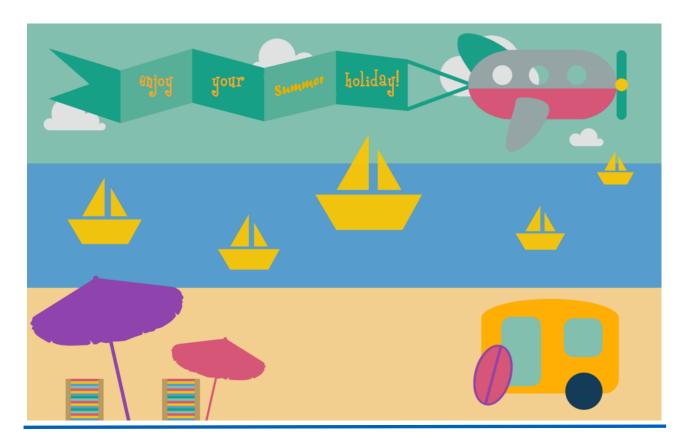
