1.	Contact learners enrolled on the affected courses and provide them with a timescale to finish any Shockwave reliant courses they have started	A full report of all courses, delegat
		1. Go to the Tracking System
		From the Delegates, Course Delegates tab choose All courses
		3. Choose the Customise Grid button
		4. Then the <u>Column Chooser</u> tab
		5. From here you can select the information you need to appear in your report
		6. Click the tick in the top right to submit your choice
		7. Click Export to Excel and you should now have a full report that you can filter and query as appropriate

3.	If applicable remove any learning links to Shockwave courses from your Intranet and emails etc	
4.	Set up (if you've not already done so) "For the Workplace" courses and make these available to all new learners via your Learning Portal	https://www.dls.nhs.uk/help/Creatinganewcustomisedcourse.html
5.	If applicable update the new "For the workplace" learning links to your Intranet, emails etc	
6.	When the timescale for learners enrolled on affected courses has expired, make the Shockwave reliant course/s inactive in the Tracking System	https://www.dls.nhs.uk/tracking/faqs?tag=CourseSetupInactive
