### 2019 Annual Survey Report Published

We are excited to announce that we've published the 2019 annual survey report. Thank you to all customers who participated in this survey and to all centres that continue to provide us with feedback and suggestions throughout the year.



With customer satisfaction high on our agenda, we conduct annual surveys to help us drive Digital Learning Solutions forward and ensure we're delivering the very best, high-quality products and services, influenced by you our customers. We are extremely pleased to see that this year we have achieved even higher levels of satisfaction in our survey than in the previous year.

In brief the survey highlighted: -

- There was an overall **95% satisfaction rate** with products and services.
- 57% of respondents utilise the Digital Learning Solutions Tracking System as their primary or only source of training
- Only 8% of respondents stated they would be able to fund their own IT Skills programme

In a very small number of cases, respondents indicated they were dissatisfied with one or more aspects of what is provided. In each case this has been followed up with the individual and, where appropriate, processes and future practices have been modified (the details of which are included within the full report).

The team are clearly very pleased with the overall levels of satisfaction amongst our customers which we believe reflects our commitment to providing an excellent service. It is our intention to continue to look at ways to improve things still further, even where areas are already performing very well.

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## New System Features Released—Reminder

The DLS web platform was updated with some exciting new features on Wednesday 30th October. The updates are part of a comprehensive development roadmap for the platform to improve the delivery of digital learning.



This update introduced new features to the system, including:

- *The option for DLS Centre Managers to elevate a DLS delegate (learner) account to an admin / supervisor account.*
- *The ability to deliver skills self-assessments (to allow staff to assess their skills and competence against a role-based skills profile)*
- *The option to identify a supervisor for a course with supervisor sign-off of self-assessments*
- *A new supervisor interface for reviewing and signing off progress*
- *The optional inclusion of a development log to courses, allowing delegates to plan and record offline learning interventions related to their course and (optionally) upload associated evidence.*

Comprehensive system help is available to support centres with this new functionality.

## New national content available from ESR—important reminder

Adobe Shockwave was discontinued in April 2019 and is no longer available for download or supported. Therefore, the national DLS IT Skills Pathway content available from ESR will be replaced with new "for the Workplace" courses that do not rely on the plug-in. **Current learners enrolled on a course via ESR will need to complete by 31st March 2020.** All new enrolments from 1st December 2019 should be made to the new "for the Workplace" courses.

Those centres that use ESR to deliver DLS IT Skills Pathway courses should communicate this to current learners so that they are aware of the end date — **31st March 2020.**
