Advanced notice of planned system downtime

When? - Monday 8 November 2021 between 19:00 and 21:00

This means that all Digital Learning Solutions systems will be unavailable between 19:00 and 21:00 on Monday 8 November 2021 and you should notify your learners they will be unable to use the system during this time.

Why? - we're taking a short break to implement some small development changes and updates:

- Move to SendGrid to improve email handling
- Removal of the "Account Type" pick list at registration. All users will register as a "Delegate (learner)." Delegates can be promoted to other roles (e.g., Tracking System administrator), as appropriate, by a centre manager
- Release of refactored login and account management

What does this mean for you and your learners? Neither you as administrators nor your learners will be able to access any of our systems during the downtime period.

What will happen if a new learner tries to register during the downtime? The learner will receive a browser error.

What do centre administrators need to do? <u>Notify your learners they will be unable</u> to use the system during this time.

We apologise for any inconvenience this may cause.



New Look Tracking System — Update

On the 8th November a **small** release of specific developments will be published into the live environment.



Read on to learn about the subtle changes that administrators and learners will see soon.

Important reminder - All delegates will need an email address

Delegates who do not have an email address registered against their DLS accounts will need to add one to their delegate account **prior** to the release to continue accessing the system.

Centres will need to advise any registered delegates at their centre without an email address to update their account from **MY DELEGATE DETAILS** at login. Alternatively centre administrators can edit the delegate details and add an email address on behalf of the delegate.

Refactor - Partial release 8th November

We're planning to release some minor developments on 8th November. There will be some small changes noticeable in the Learning Portal, to administrators and learners, once the update is available in the live system. We don't anticipate that delegates will be disrupted by these minor changes as they have been designed to enhance the user experience in partnership with the focus groups.


How will delegates and administrators be affected?

The release will deliver some minor navigation changes:

- Log out tab has been removed
- My account tab has been added
- The order of tabs has changed

CURRENT Learning Portal tabs for Administrators and Learners:




FUTURE Learning Portal tabs for Administrators:




FUTURE Learning Portal tabs for Delegates:



The Learning Portal **Switch application** tab will be replaced with the *new* **My account** tab. Here delegates and administrators can amend and update details, manage their password, notifications and **Log out**. Administrators will still have access to the **Switch application** tab.








Choosing **Log out** from the **My** account tab will return delegates and administrators to the new main site **Log in** screen



The **Switch application** tab (only available to administrators) will display the new application selector and show the services that you are authorised to access.





New process to register administrators—Reminder

Along with the new releases detailed above we'll also be publishing an update to improve the registration process. **On the 8th November** we'll be **removing** the option for all new users to change the **Account Type** at registration. The only option available at registration will be **Delegate (Learner)**.

All administrator registrations will be actioned by the centre manager who will promote delegates, where appropriate, to administrators.



The promote to administrator functionality is already available to centres and we want all centres to start using this approach now in readiness for the switch over. Guidance about the promote functionality is available from the Tracking System <u>Help</u>.

Centre managers are advised to ensure all administrator outstanding approvals have been processed before the end of October.

Email notification issues—update

We have been working as a priority to rectify email notifications from the DLS platform that have been failing to reach some external email addresses (especially @hotmail and @outlook.com addresses) as the messages are being blocked.

We are anticipating that the update on the 8th November, which will include the move to SendGrid, should improve email handling. We will continue to monitor the situation after the update and centres can report any issues they experience with email notifications via ticket support.

Please help us to avoid further problems with DLS notifications by ensuring that users are expecting any emails you trigger from the system. For example, if you are registering delegates and sending "Welcome to DLS" messages, please make sure they are expecting the email before it arrives. When users mark DLS notifications as "Junk", it results in DLS being blacklisted and our messages being blocked.
