Get Ready for Passwords in 2018—Important information for all centres

Password access to the IT Skills Pathway will become mandatory for your learners on:

14th May 2018

All learners who access IT Skills Pathway learning and testing materials will be prompted to set up a password, if one hasn't already been set, when they access the **Learning Portal** and **Learning Links** from **14th May 2018**.



New resources are now available to centres from the **Tracking System, Resources**, **Trainer Resources**, **Documents—ITSP001**, **ITSP002**, **ITSP003**, **ITSP004** & **ITSP005** to help manage the change.

Below is a summary of the new password security changes learners can expect:-

- <u>Passwords will no longer be optional</u>. A user must set a password when they log in if one hasn't already been set.
- Passwords must meet minimum complexity rules: 8 characters with at least one letter, one number and one symbol.
- If a delegate has already set a password that doesn't meet the complexity criteria they will be prompted to set a new one that does when they next try to log in.
- Learners can receive an automated email to reset the password should it be forgotten.
- Failed login attempts won't trigger an account lock-out.

Mandating passwords is in line with best practice, proves identity, and protects security and confidentiality for your learners.


Revealing the new look Tracking System, coming soon to your centre.


This month we focus on Course Setup & the Learning menu...

New Tracking System—What will happen on 14th May?

- Q. How do I login?
- A. Just click the usual link to the Tracking System: https://www.itskills.nhs.uk/tracking
 You may be asked to set a new password if your current password does not meet the secure password criteria, see Get Ready for Passwords in 2018.
- Q. How do I get help?
- **A.** Comprehensive **Help** is available throughout the system

- Q. Do we need to send out new links to courses and the Learning Portal?
- A. NO, learners will continue to use the same links.
- Q. What about our learners?
- A. They'll need to set a secure password next time they login, see <u>Get Ready for Passwords in 2018</u>. When they login they'll see the new look <u>learning menu.</u>

To reassure centres, for a temporary period, all centres will be able to access the legacy system should they need to.

New rules relating to how we collect and process personal data - the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) - will come into effect in the UK from 25 May 2018.

Here at the IT Skills Pathway we're getting ready for GDPR, we expect you'll be involved with this activity at your centre and will have some insight into the new regulations for protecting data. GDPR expects us to know and tell individuals what personal data we hold and what we do with it and have a legal reason to do so. We can't do this when centres are able to define their own custom fields for learner registration.

So as we prepare to ensure that we all comply with GDPR we need to bring to the attention of centres the collection of data at registration and as delegates enrol to new courses. Historically centres have been able to set up free text "extra questions" supplementary to the standard questions in the custom fields. This is now the area of the system that is of most concern in relation to GDPR.

For all of us involved with the collection of data within the IT Skills Pathway to meet our GDPR responsibilities we are obliged to modify the **Registration Custom Fields** and consolidate to a pick list as below

From 14th May the free text fields will no longer be available. IT Skills Pathway centres can choose to collect any three of the following pieces of information in the **Registration Custom Fields**, to enable them to effectively manage learning:

- Assignment / employee number
- Base / office / place of work
- Contact telephone number
- Department / team
- Division / directorate / service
- Group
- Job title
- Manager
- Organisation / company

- Organisation identifier (e.g. ODS Code)
- Organisation type
- Programme of study / course
- Region
- Role type
- Sector
- Team
- Work address



Existing data will be mapped, where possible, to these fields and we'll be contacting centres over the next few weeks so they are aware of the data that will be mapped and what will be removed.

To comply with GDPR we will be removing the **Course Custom Fields** from the system and erasing the data as the questions asked are too wildly varied for us to consolidate.

We've updated our **Terms and Conditions of Use, Privacy Notice and Accessibility Help** and added a footer link from on all our web applications. These documents are also available in the Tracking System from the **Resources** tab, **Technical Support**, please familiarise yourselves with this important information about the protection of data when you use our systems.
