Speed up Responses to your Support Tickets

If you have a technical issue that needs resolving, the ticket tab of the Tracking System is by far the best way of getting it resolved quickly. To help you get speedy replies when raising tickets it would be really useful to include the following information (if relevant) when reporting issues:-

Adobe Shockwave Version (e.g. 12,1,0,150) Browser type/version (e.g. Internet Explorer 9/Google Chrome/Mozilla Firefox etc.) Course Link (a copy of the URL link to the course being used)

This saves you and the support team time having to go back and forth to get this information.

Do your Learners know how to Contact you?

We've recently had an increasing number of learners contact our team directly looking for information or help with their IT Skills Pathway courses. The service has been developed to ensure that centres should always be a learner's point of contact. You can clearly signpost how learners should contact you by using the 'banner text' (configured via the Dashboard screen on the tracking system). This will help them to get the most appropriate support when they need it.
