The courses above are HTML 5.0 format and will run on most modern browsers without issue (<u>no Shockwave is required</u>). All you'll need is Cookies Enabled and <a href="https://www.itskills.nhs.uk">https://www.itskills.nhs.uk</a> added to your Trusted Sites.

## Can your learners find you?

#### 1. When a learner needs help....




