"How to...."

Each month we share with centres the most common question raised via our Service Desk tickets and the response.....

Q. I'm a Tracking System administrator, you've published some new courses recently, how can I make these available at my centre?

A. It's easy to make a new course available at your centre:-

- 1. Go to the Tracking System, **Course setup** tab, below the **centre courses** grid is the **Create new course** panel.
- 2. From the drop down menu select one of the available courses to create, for example: **Digital Skills for the Workplace** and click **Add**. The drop down will contain all of the master courses that have been published and are available to you centre.



- 3. Use the **Edit Course** form to name your course and customise it to your requirements (see Tracking System **Help** for **Customisation Options**).
- 4. Click **Submit** to save your course.

The newly created course should now appear on the **Course Setup** centre courses grid.
