Have you used the new Consolidation exercises and Videos?

After having released the first of our Level Two learning materials (Word 2007) in August we received some feedback with recommendations around how they could be improved.

It was suggested that learners would benefit from being able to practice what they had learnt as they progressed through the materials. With this in mind the IT Skills Pathway Design Group set about producing consolidation exercises for the Level Two and Three materials. These extra examples will help learners to cement their learning by following the exercises in the downloadable file within the learning materials. We currently have the Level Two Word 2007 exercises available and are working on the production of the others.

We have also produced some videos that compliment the elearning. The videos have been created to give learners examples of how the learning that they are about to undertake could be useful within their day to day working


