- Potential centres thinking about becoming a centre. You can get an overview of the system and the benefits for your organisation





For example, if you have a learner who needs to know how to create tables in Word, charts in Excel and present them in PowerPoint, you can create a tailored piece of learning from existing Pathway learning, all combined into one course using the CMS.
