Tracking System Release—Version 6.0

The new updated tracking system (Version 6.0) will be released on the 1st of July.


With Version 6.0 you will see no major changes to the look and feel of the system, it will however incorporate the new menus for entry level and level 1 courses to bring the whole system in to line with the level 2 and level 3 menus.

These changes will ensure your learners have a consistent journey on the IT Skills Pathway by giving them the additional functionality for entry level and level 1 courses that they already receive for level 2 and 3 courses.

2. When creating a new course you will only have the option of using the new style menus as you can see below, there are no entries in the dropdown for "OLD".



3. The Course Setup menu for both Entry Level and Level 1 courses now show the same functionality as Level 2 and 3.



4. This screenshot shows the menu that the learners will now see for an Entry Level course, this will be the same for Level 1 and will give the learners a consistent experience throughout the IT Skills Pathway.
