New Learning Portal—Live

Just a reminder for those centres that don't already know, **the new IT Skills Pathway** Learning Portal is now live for all centres. The Learning Portal is the new one stop shop for your learners to access current learning, see their achievements, enrol on new courses and search the Knowledge Bank.



To learn more about the Learning Portal and how to configure for your centre, see the FAQs available from the Tracking System, **Support/FAQs** tabs. A **Learning Portal Quick Start Guide** for your learners is also available from the Tracking System, **Resources** tab, **Trainer Resources**.

Please note: For those centres who use Internet Explorer, we are aware that IE9 or higher (with compatibility mode turned off) is the minimum requirement to run the Learning Portal.

Although you may be launching the Learning Portal in IE9 or higher, your local settings may be using compatibility mode and defaulting the page down to an earlier IE version.

You can check this by loading the page and pressing **F12** for developer tools. In the **Mode** section, check the **Document mode** this may display an earlier (compatibility) version. To override for your learners you will need to seek support from your local IT Department. **This will enable you to launch everything via IE for your learners.**

Measuring the Effectiveness of Courses Offered at your Centre



Whenever a student completes a course on the IT Skills Pathway they are invited to fill in a survey about their experience. This data can provide valuable management information for your centre and can help you in assessing if the courses offered to your learners are improving the IT Skills of the workforce.

You can now download this information from the Tracking System and produce reports by following the **Evaluation Reporting Guide** (with pre-prepared formulas), available from the Tracking System, **Resources** tab, **Trainer Resources**.


