




MOST awards for 2013

Just a quick reminder that June 2013 will be the last month where exams will qualify for the annual MOST awards.



The awards count exams from July 1 2012 until 30 June 2013 and are awarded as follows:

- 50 exam passes = Centre of Merit certificate
- 100 exam passes = Centre of Excellence plaque
- Top centre per region = award to centre with most exam passes in old SHA regions (subject to minimum of 100 exam passes)
- Top centre for country = award to centre in NHS England with the most overall exam passes

Things are currently pretty tight at the top so good luck!
