YOU SAID WE DID - New Developments to the IT Skills Pathway Tracking System

Following rounds of discussions with all our IT Skills Pathway Centres, we had some excellent feedback on the IT Skills Pathway Tracking System. We took what you asked for and made it happen:

You Said	We did		
1. Can we see a preview of the certificate?	This has been added to the Dashboard		
	screen.		
2. Can the appropriate level be added to the certificate?	This has been added to the certificate.		
3. We can't print certificates from the learn- er's detailed progress for Level 2/3 courses?	You can now.		
4. Can we see a breakdown of Diagnostic scores and Post Learning Assessments out-comes for Level 2/3 courses?	This has been added.		
5. Can you add the number of assessment attempts to the CSV download for course delegates?	This has been added to the CSV download.		
6. Rather than having to manually check, can we receive an email to notify us about learners that require approval before they can undertake Level 2/3 courses?	A 'Notify email' field has been added to the Dashboard screen in the 'Edit Details' dia- log box. This must be filled in otherwise no email will be sent.		
7. Can we deactivate or delete centre ad- ministrators that are no longer needed?	A delete box has been added to the Centre Logins tab. (Centre Managers have these rights)		
8. My learners sometimes get confused about the assessments – what they have to do etc. I explain it to them but can we make it clearer?	New messages have been added to Diag- nostic and Post Learning Assessment screens to clarify and simplify things as much as possible for the learners.		
9. Can we see our Centre Ranking within just our region?	A Region filter box has now been added to Ranking section, this allows you to compare your ranking with other centres in your region.		
10. When working with learners, it always goes back to screen one after I close each learners record. Can it not stay on the same screen?	This has been updated so that after closing a learner's details you now remain on the same screen. It will also highlight the learn- er you have been editing most recently.		
11. Can we produce a message that lets a learner know if their screen dimensions are hiding some of the learning content?	A message now appears on screen advising the learner to maximise their window or use full screen (F11).		
12. Is it possible to highlight the course that I've been editing most recently?	This has been added.

The IT Skills Pathway is constantly being reviewed and updated to make sure the system is as interactive and user friendly as possible.
