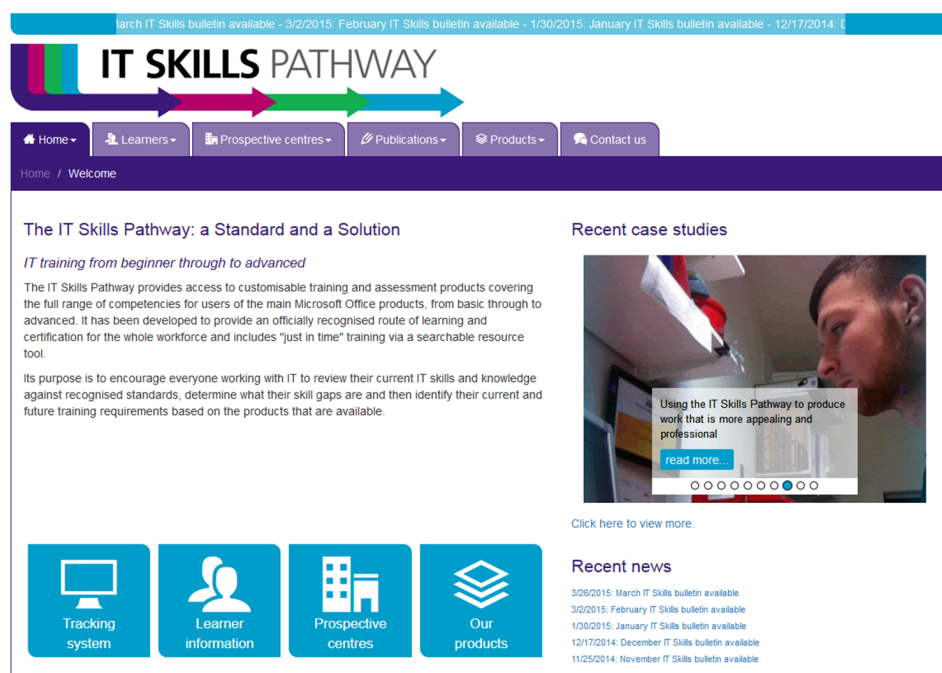


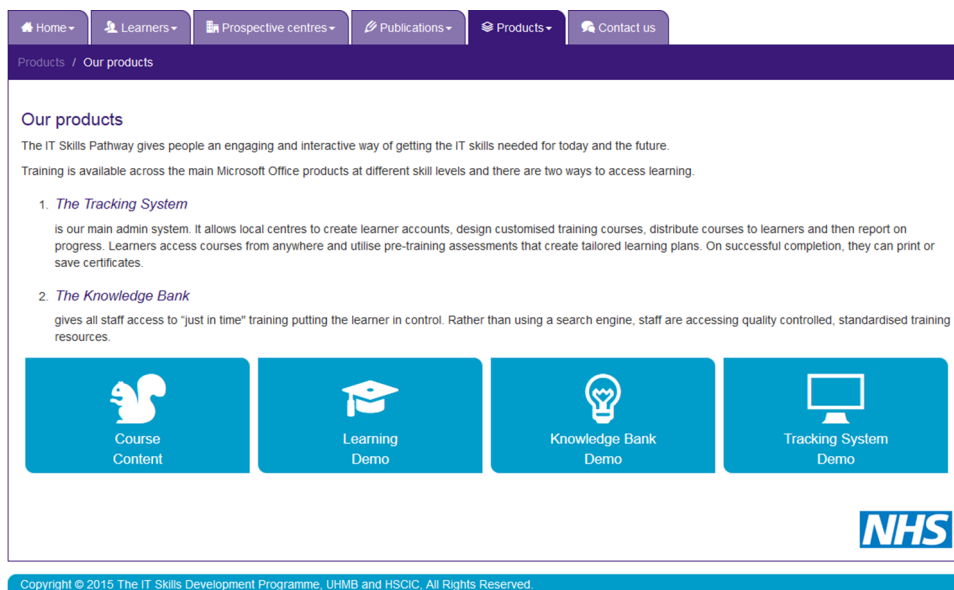

The Products page highlights our products including video demonstrations.



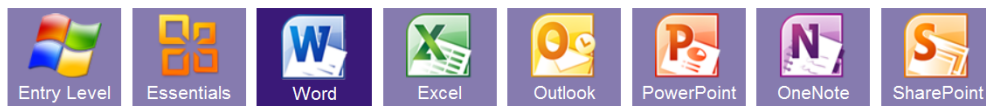
New IT Skills Pathway Website (cont'd)

NHS: WIDENING DIGITAL PARTICIPATION

One of the most significant benefits of getting online is the health improvement it can bring, both to individuals and to communities. That's why Tinder Foundation are working in partnership with the NHS as part of the Widening Digital Participation programme, aiming to reduce health inequalities among older people, disabled people and those on low incomes.

Year 1 (2013-2014)

Tinder aim to engage 100,000 people throughout the programme, training 50,000 to use health information online. This will be done through a Digital Health Information Network of 400 centres engaging these hard-to-reach groups, alongside development of specialist online learning content through a digital health portal on the [Learn My Way website](#).
