



The Products page highlights our products including video demonstrations.






New IT Skills Pathway Website (cont'd)

NHS: WIDENING DIGITAL PARTICIPATION

One of the most significant benefits of getting online is the health improvement it can bring, both to individual and to communities. That's why Tinder Foundation are working in partnership with the NHS as part of the Widening Digital Participation programme, aiming to reduce health inequalities among older people, disabled people and those on low incomes.

Following requests from a number of centres the Average Course Length is now available for each course to give both Admins and Learners an idea of how long the course will take to complete.


