Once these courses have been quality tested they will be published to all centres from the **Course Setup** tab, where they can be customised and made available for your learners. **PowerPoint and Excel for the Workplace** will follow on in the New Year.

New HTML 5.0 Courses

As you may be aware all new course materials developed for the IT Skills Pathway are in the **new HTML 5.0 format**, moving away from the requirement to have plugin technology which can be problematic. This has many advantages with the main one being that the new courses will run on most modern browsers without issue. It should however be noted, for those centres who use Internet Explorer, that IE9 (with compatibility mode turned off) is the minimum requirement to run the new courses. 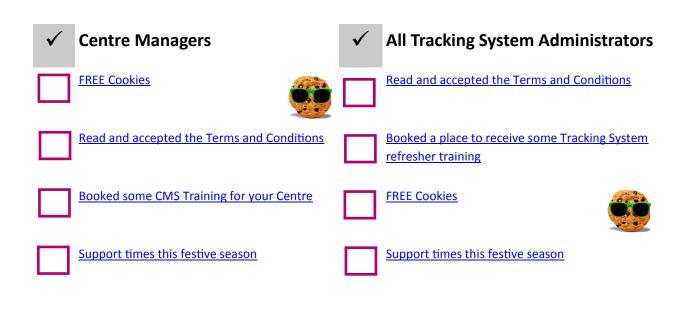
IT Skills Pathway Tracking System Training Webinars
