Over the coming months, the IT Skills Pathway will be transitioning to a new name – Digital Learning Solutions.

Why make this change?

Whilst generic IT training (MS Office, Digital Skills etc.) will always be an important part of what we offer, more recent developments such as Content Creator and the Content Management System and proposed future



developments such as more Learning Management System (LMS) functionality have led us to the conclusion that our current name doesn't accurately reflect what we do anymore.

2018 Annual Survey—Published

A big thank you from us to all the centres who completed the 2018 survey.

The <u>Annual Survey 2018</u> has now been published and is available from the IT Skills Pathway website and the Tracking System, **Resources**, **Trainer Resources**.

In summary: The results of the survey continue to demonstrate that there is both a high level of satisfaction with the products currently provided and a continued need for their provision. There is also significant interest in utilising the new products that have recently been released and showcased to centres.

In brief the survey highlighted: -

- ♦ There was an overall 93% satisfaction rate with products and services
- ♦ 59% of respondents utilise the IT Skills Pathway Tracking System as their primary or only source of training
- Only 4% of respondents stated they would be able to fund their own IT Skills programme

In a very small number of cases, respondents indicated they were dissatisfied with one or more aspects of what is provided. In each case this has been followed up with the individual and, where appropriate, processes and future practices have been modified (the details of which are included in the full report).

The team are clearly very pleased with overall levels of satisfaction amongst our customers which we believe reflects our commitment to providing an excellent service. It is our intention to continue to look at ways to improve things still further, even where areas are already performing very well.

"How to...."

When setting up the new courses (with learning only) you should switch off,

Diagnostics and **Post Learning Assessment** and set the **Required diagnostic score** to **0**, then **Submit**. This will set the completion criteria for the course.
