Self Registration - Approval needed (Part 2)

When a candidate registers outside of the approved NHS network the system will automatically pick up the IP address and ask the centre manager to approve the registration through their dashboard. The development team have added extra information onto the centre dashboard (Figure 1) which shows your IP address and the Preapproved IP prefix of your organisation. There is also an information button which explains this (Figure 2).

Preapproved IP Address Prefix

For course customisations where self-registration is switched on, learner registrations will need approval by a centre administrator unless registration happens from within the centre's network.

To check this, we compare the IP address of the person registering with a predetermined IP address prefix. If it doesn't match, the registration will not be automatically approved.

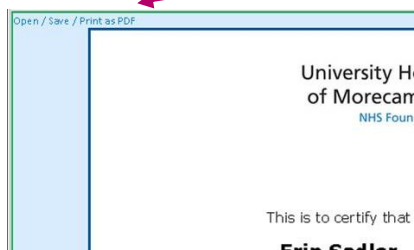
If you need to change your pre-approved IP address prefix, please raise a support ticket indicating the prefix that you need it changing to. Usually this will be the first three parts of your IP address.

Following feedback from some of our IT Skills Pathway Centres, We took what you asked for and made it happen:

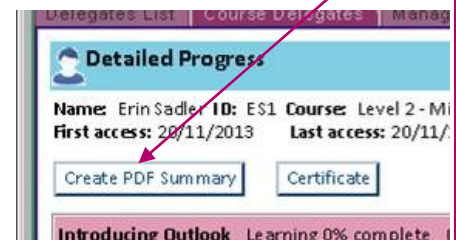
1) When you produce a certificate (either as a learner or from the tracking system), the option to output it to PDF is now available in the top left corner:
