

Digital Skills - New Course Available Now

The new Digital Skills course is now live with diagnostic and post learning assessments. Working in conjunction with the existing Digital Literacy course this now gives you a suite of entry level learning materials that are not dependent on Adobe Shockwave and will work in any modern Internet browser.



To add the Digital Skills course to your centre's course list, from the Course Setup tab in the tracking system, select Entry Level—Digital Skills, Create New Course. From here you can customise the course.

The course can be customised in the same way as all other courses making it ideal for use as a learning needs analysis (LNA), a short course in basic mouse, keyboard and web skills or a full Entry Level course.

The new **Office Essentials** diagnostics are ready to be tested. Testing is likely to take place mid-October and we are calling for volunteers from our Centres to test and feedback. Testing and feedback from Centres is vital, ensuring that we are able to publish a quality product for you to deliver to your learners.

Important Security Information for your Centre - Reminder

The IT Skills Pathway Service takes Information Governance very seriously and understand that this is also of paramount importance to all our Centres. It has come to our attention that there have been 2 isolated cases where a Centre has been directed to another Centre's tracking system pages. This is unacceptable and we need to take action to ensure that this never happens again.

This issue is due to session tokens (unique identifiers) being stored in the address bar when cookies are disabled by the browser. It is therefore proposed that the safest solution is to switch off cookieless access to prevent this.

To support this important security work immediate action needs to be taken by all Centres as follows:

- Ensure <u>www.itskills.nhs.uk</u> is added to your trusted sites
- Always access the tracking system from a "pure" link i.e. https://www.itskills.nhs.uk/tracking/
 there should be no other alpha or numeric content following the address, these suffixes are the session tokens*



- Learning links should be the address created from the URL/email links in the course set up with no session tokens*
- Never create or distribute links that include a session token*
- Don't add links to Favorites that include a session token*

Completing the steps above will ensure that a new session token* is issued each time you visit and you won't be incorrectly identified by the server.

Please share this information with your teams who access the tracking system to manage, administer and support training. Regular reminders will appear in this bulletin and centres who have not either added the IT Skills Pathway to trusted sites or enabled cookies within 6 months will have their access turned off.

Content Management System (CMS) - Training Dates

We continue to have a high demand for CMS training, further dates have been released for October and more dates will be made available throughout the year. **Centre Managers should attend along with their team** and after training all attendees will be provided with user access to the system.

Autumn Tracking System Tidy Up - Are Your Contact Details up to Date?


To help with your queries and keep you up to date with new developments please ensure we have the correct contact details registered for you. To check this please take the following action:-

Centre Managers and Administrators: -

- Log into the Tracking System
- Click on My Details
- Check your details
- Enter your Tracking System centre password if anything is incorrect
- Update
- Click **OK** to confirm changes

Centre Managers:-

- Check your Centre Details on the dashboard
- Updated by clicking Edit Details
- Confirm details to update



Go to the **Centre Logins Tab** and delete the user accounts of Administrators who are not currently active on the Tracking System. A change of Centre Manager must be notified by raising a ticket on the Tracking System.
