Word and PowerPoint RFM elearning released

In the November bulletin we told you about the new elearning that was being produced for Ready for MOST (RFM) – our level 1 product. Ready for MOST (level 1) is a set of learning materials that has been specifically designed to bridge the gap that exists between NHS ELITE (entry level) and the full NHS MOST (level 2 and 3) training.

We are very pleased to inform you that the first two elearning modules, Word and PowerPoint in 2007, will be released on Friday 2 Feruary.

The new elearning materials will be accessible via the online NHS IT skills tracking system. The tracking system currently hosts NHS ELITE (entry level), so learners will be able to progress their learning using materials that look and feel the same as those they're already used to. As well as one log in for learners, it also means that trainers and training centres can access both sets of elearning from the same place too! The materials have been produced by University Hospitals of Morecambe Bay NHS Foundation Trust with the input of the NHS IT skills development design group. In addition, a few of our training centres kindly offered their time to assist the design group to review the materials. We would like to send our thanks to those training centres and the design group members for their help.

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


