Improvements to GMetrix Practice Test Software

The GMetrix practice test software used to prepare candidates for MOST exams now has the facility to allow you to create "Cross Application Custom Tests".

As its title suggests, this now means that you can create a practice exam for candidates that covers multiple applications. This may have a variety of uses including as part of recruitment processes or where you have identified learning needs across multiple applications.

To create the new custom exams, log into GMetrix as an administrator and select the "Custom Tests" option.

Free touch typing learning materials

In November 2010 we informed our distribution list of a three year agreement for the NHS to access free touch typing learning materials using E-Type.

The e-type online learning materials teach touch typing skills in 10 lessons which take 10 – 20 hours to complete over a period of a few weeks of self study.

There are further lessons in the programme which will help staff to increase their speed and accuracy when typing. As the learning materials are accessed via the Internet, staff can

use them at home as well as at work by logging on with their own unique user name and password.

As part of this package we agreed a two for the price of one reduced rate for the formal tests with the BCS, which are undertaken on the BCS testing system.

We currently have 143 centres who have taken up the free learning materials with

some of these also having taken up the offer of reduced price tests.

Ready for MOST reminder and 2010 release schedule

This is a quick reminder, for those who missed our last bulletin, to say that all of the Ready for MOST materials in 2007 are now available on the IT skills tracking system.

We can also now give you some more information about the 2010 versions of RFM. Office Essentials will be released first in early summer closely followed by Word and PowerPoint and Excel in late summer.

For those who aren't aware, Office Essentials covers key and often reoccurring elements within Office applications such as starting and closing applications and using the ribbon. It is also an ideal training tool for using with learners that are migrating to the newest versions of Office.

If you are not yet set up as a centre on the tracking system, we would strongly encourage you to do so to enable you to get access to these and all future elearning products as they will not be available in any other format. Centre activity ranking on the tracking system to cover all activity

Centres using the tracking system will know that the top 10 centres are listed on the dashboard of the system, which is currently calculated using learner's usage of the learning materials.

We have been made aware that quite a few centres use the assessment (as a training needs analysis (TNA) for induction or during the interview process) extensively with less use of the actual materials meaning that they would never have been included in the top 10 list.

To make the top 10 centres list more representative of centres usage of all elements available within the tracking system we are changing it to cover all activity which will include the use of assessments as well as the learning materials. These changes will be implemented on Tuesday 3 April so you are likely to see a shift in the centre order on that date.

This change will also mean that the information we provide you with on the bulletin will be changing, instead of the 'Top 10 NHS ELITE centres' it will be 'Top 10 centres using the tracking system', the 'Top 10 NHS MOST centres' will remain the same.
