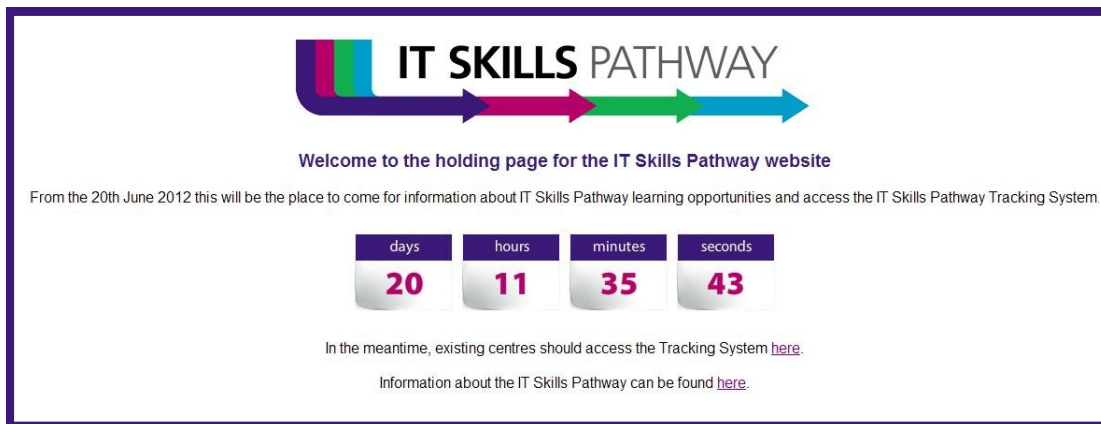

Testers needed for new Level Two Word Core module

Office Essentials 2010 released to Tracking System

We are pleased to announce that the Level One (Ready for MOST) Office Essentials 2010 module is now available for centres to use on the tracking system (it is already available in Office 2007).

Office Essentials covers key and often recurring elements within Office applications such as starting and closing applications and using the ribbon. It is also an ideal training tool for using with learners that are migrating to the newest versions of Office.

The materials have been produced by University Hospitals of Morecambe Bay NHS Foundation Trust with the input of the NHS IT Skills Development Design Group.
