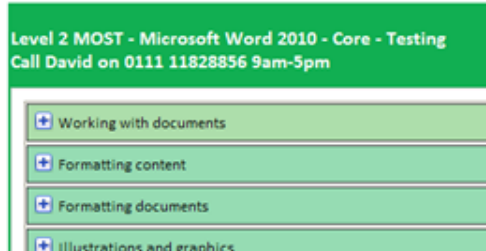
Level Two Learning Materials Update

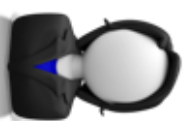
