

Content Management System (CMS) Update

The new CMS has now been piloted and is ready to be launched.

The CMS, for anyone who hasn't already heard:-

1. Allows you to create your own versions of our normal courses

2. Lets you combine existing courses (e.g. put Word, Excel and PowerPoint all into one course)

So the CMS enables centres to create customised learning from existing courses. For example you have a learner who needs to know how to create tables in Word, charts in Excel and present them in PowerPoint, you can create a tailored piece of learning from existing Pathway learning using the CMS.

Future developments to the CMS will enable centres to host locally developed learning and assessment content within our Tracking System (charges apply).

Digital Skills Crisis – or is it?

A report published by the UK Government's Commons Science and Technology Committee earlier this month warned that urgent action is needed to deal with the UK's digital skills crisis. The GOOD NEWS for our Centres is the IT Skills Pathway Service provides access to free of charge Digital Skills training and assessments for the current and future Health & Social Care workforce. The full report is available <u>here</u>, in brief the report states that:-

- 12.6 million UK adults lack digital skills
- 5.8 million UK adults have never used the Internet at all
- The UK needs another 745,000 workers with digital skills by 2017
- 90% of UK jobs require digital skills to some degree
- The digital skills gap costs the UK economy around £63bn a year in lost income

The IT Skills Pathway is your solution to fill the Digital skills gap and upskill the Health and Social Care workforce.

IT Skills Pathway Tracking System Webinar
